






QUALIFIED ATTENDEES BY TITLE



INTERNATIONAL ATTENDEES BY COUNTRY




QUALIFIED ATTENDEES BY PURCHASING POWER

Deposits are refundable before July 1, 2011; a 10% cancellation fee will be imposed to cover AES administrative expenses. Any reduction in exhibit space as requested on the Exhibitor Application shall incur a 10% fee of the entire exhibit price to cover AES administrative expenses.

Exhibitors are subject to a cancellation charge for the entire Exhibit Space originally applied for as follows:

50% cancellation charge of the entire exhibition space price after July 1, 2011.

75% cancellation charge of the entire exhibition space price after August 1, 2011.

100% cancellation charge of the entire exhibition space price after September 2, 2011.
